- 5. Feeling or Touch


III. Free Will: Or Self Determination

The "heart" capacity to originate and be responsible for our own actions.


Three Levels of Choice Making Are:



- •Think what you will say ahead of time.
- •Think of the best way to communicate:

- C. Letter

DON'T SAY:

- a. "I was wrong, but so were you."
- b. "Sorry, but it wasn't my fault."
- c. "I just couldn't help it."
- d. "Sorry if I have hurt you."
