3. You DO WHAT IS RIGHT and you will BE RIGHT


★The Natural Law of Consequences!







5. **Feeling or Touch**


III. Free Will: Or Self Determination

Three Levels of Choice Making Are:


- I. **Ultimate Or Supreme Choices** (*Only a possibility of two*)
 - A. To do the will of God.
 - B. To live selfishly.
- II. **Subordinate or the Means Chosen to Further the Ultimate or Supreme Choice.**
- III. **Resultant Choices**



Cautions in Confession

- Go to the offended one, don't involve others.
- Avoid shameful details.
- Realize the other people may feel guilty as you make restitution, not a good time to witness.
- Be brief, clear and to the point.
- Don't put it off.
- Choose proper time, place and situation.
- Think what you will say ahead of time.
- Think of the best way to communicate:

A. In person

D. Email

B. Phone

C. Letter

DON'T SAY:

- a. "I was wrong, but so were you."
- b. "Sorry, but it wasn't my fault."
- c. "I just couldn't help it."
- d. "Sorry if I have hurt you."

In your confession, name the **Basic Sin**: Rebellion, pride, lust, selfishness, ingratitude, anger, defrauding, envy or levity.

Include these words in your restitution: "I want to apologize and ask your forgiveness for... Will you forgive me?"

OR

"I took... and I have come to repay you..., will you forgive me?"
